

Nursery Supply List

- A large pack of diapers (**child's name on the pack/box**)
- Two changes of clothes, including socks, in a large Ziploc bag **labeled with your child's** name to be left at school.
- A backpack or diaper bag designated for school with your child's name on it (to send home artwork and school letters/information).
- One or more bottles (this will be sent back home each day) **labeled with your child's name** on the bottle and bottle lid. **No glass bottles please.**
- If applicable, a sippy cup each day filled with milk, water or juice (this will be sent back home each day) **labeled with your child's name.** Empty cups are refilled with water unless milk is sent from home.
- Formula or Breast Milk. Formula must be pre-mixed and in a non-glass pourable container or prefilled in bottles. Breast milk may be sent fresh or frozen.
- Baby food (if store bought it must be unopened)
- If your baby is eating table food they may order a lunch or bring a lunch from home.
- If your baby is eating table food please send snacks of your preference for your child each day.
- Plastic 2-pocket prong folder **labeled with your child's name**
- Six packages of baby wipes
- Two containers of Clorox wipes (or similar type product)
- One can of Lysol spray (or similar aerosol product)
- Four boxes of 100 count latex free gloves (Your child's teacher must wear a fresh pair of gloves each time they change your child's diaper.)

EVERYTHING should have your child's name on it. Your child's name on all personal items is emphasized so that there is no confusion with bottles, cups, food, blankets, pacifiers, etc.

If your child has sensitivity to wipes, please let us know and we will use only the brand you provide. Otherwise wipes are used communally.

Wubbanub style pacifiers may not be used for children under the age of 12 months.
