

## Elementary Supply List

- A change of clothes, including socks, in a large Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name to be kept in the student's backpack.
- A backpack (to keep up with personal items)
- One box of gallon Ziplock bags
- One bottle of hand soap (not hand sanitizer)
- One prewashed white t-shirt for tie-dye. Please label inside the collar!

EVERYTHING should have your child's name on it. Your child's name on all items is emphasized so that there is no confusion. Many days students will need a sack lunch in a disposable bag. Please be sure to check your child's calendar each day.

We ask that tennis shoes or closed toe shoes are encouraged instead of sandals, flip flops, or crocs. This is a safety factor for falls and dropped toys. Please keep in mind that we will work with paints (washable), markers, outside play, etc. that require appropriate clothing. If weather permits, we will be outside every day. Please keep this in mind and apply sunscreen before coming to school.

Although we still provide each student a snack each morning, when we go on longer field trips, we have created a canteen cart for students to purchase an additional snack. If you ever attended camp as a child, you know the excitement of canteen! The math skills students use while counting their money and purchasing a snack is such a fantastic real life application! We will continue to provide a snack for your student each morning, but if your child would like to purchase an additional special snack to take on the bus, please send them with a dollar or two on field trip days. Also, the bus can be a little cold. Your child may want to bring a sweater or light jacket to wear on the bus.

If your child wants to bring an electronic device with them, please label it. They must leave the device on the bus when we get off at our destination. *Each child will be responsible for keeping up with their own electronics.*
